The Fiery server includes built-in technology that allows you to maximise engine quality to get the best possible output, with no specialized colour knowledge required.

You can also use tools on the Fiery server to help improve flaws in files, such as low resolution images.

Adding a Fiery server adds more processing horsepower to your printer. It's ideally suited for users that need to print large files - like PowerPoint or PDF, or high volumes of small files (think of an organization that prints many files to the printer at a specific time of the day). The Fiery server can help eliminate these printer bottlenecks so everyone's jobs can get printed quickly, which improves overall productivity.

The Fiery server includes the ability to make custom server presets, which automatically selects the right Job Properties. Or add optional Hot Folders/Virtual Printers (available as a standalone option or as part of the Fiery Automation Package), which makes it easy for users to print files correctly in drag and drop or File > Print workflows. Both can be configured by IT and pushed out to all users in an organization.

Fiery VUE is a free Windows application for printing booklets. You can see your booklet and even flip through the pages. It's easy to rearrange pages or merge multiple documents together, and you can change from colour to black & white and choose options to conserve paper.

The optional <u>Fiery JobExpert</u> uses intelligent automation to analyse incoming PDFs and dynamically choose the optimal print settings. It helps ensure that even inexperienced users can print files with the right settings, which reduces prep time and helps get files printed faster.		
Do you use Adobe Creative Suite to create files for print?	Yes	No
Designers continue to push creative boundaries with features in Adobe Creative Suite applications, creating files with complex effects, such as soft feathered edges, drop shadows, overlapping elements, and more. These complex files are typically saved as an Adobe PDF, which captures all elements of a printed document as an electronic image that can be viewed and printed. The optional Adobe PDF Print Engine uses the same Adobe PDF technology as other Adobe applications, so it keeps the files in their native PDF format when processing to print, improving the consistency, reliability, and predictability of the printed output from design to print.		
Does your organisation produce documents that need to be imposed or ganged up?	Yes	No
If you frequently produces applications like business cards, postcards, coupons or booklets, you likely spend a lot of time preparing jobs to be printed. With the optional Fiery Impose, you visually impose pages with precise information about the printable area on the sheet and can automate those tasks so job prep time is reduced significantly.		



Do you need to correct colour and images on the fly?	Yes	No
Sometimes you need to make last-minute edits to files before printing, such as colour and image corrections. Optional tools for the Fiery server (Fiery ColorRight Package) make it easy to touch up files as needed and get your files out.		
Are you running jobs on a variety of different media that requires a consistent colour quality across jobs?	Yes	No
Fiery servers include colour profiles for most common paper types such as glossy, matte, etc. Reaching the optimum colour quality across different media requires the creation of custom media profiles (using the optional Fiery Color Profiler Suite) to adapt to the specific characteristics of the paper you have.

Many organisations use JDF to integrate with print workflow and business management systems. The Fiery server provides an optional package (<u>Fiery Automation Package</u>) that includes JDF connectivity.		
Do you create and design personalised communications for print?	Yes	No
Fiery FreeForm Create is a free application for creating personalised files. Unlike mail merge, which creates a single, very large file, FreeForm Create outputs a file that's optimised to print more efficiently on the Fiery server. You can even add personalised images and barcodes. All you need to get started is a master PDF and an Excel doc with your data.

Available tools (IQ Manage) make managing your Fiery fleet easier. You can standardise and deploy server configurations for same printer models, check system compliance, and monitor printer status at-a-glance.
